

Quarrymill Woodland Park: Guidance for groups

THE GANNOCHY TRUST AND SCONE DEN (QUARRYMILL WOODLAND PARK)

Quarrymill was given to the Gannochy Trust by A K Bell in 1937 for the benefit of the local community. 'Scone Den' as it was once called, has a long and illustrious history. It was once home to mills that span cotton and extracted starch for the textile industry. The quarry that lies at the heart of the park once provided stone for the construction of many local landmarks, bridges and buildings.

Today the Park is the ideal place to explore the outdoors, see wildlife along our waymarked trails, soak in the views and enjoy a well-deserved brew at the Macmillan Coffee and Gift Shop.



QUARRYMILL WOODLAND PARK – GUIDANCE FOR USE

Please refer to the Scottish Outdoor Access Code before using the park and its facilities. It asks that you respect the interests of others, care for the environment, and take responsibility for your own actions. Please keep your dog/s under close control or on a short lead during Spring and Summer months (April to July) so that breeding birds are not disturbed, and always come prepared to clean up after your pet.

Facilities:

Quarrymill Woodland Park provides an abundance of wildlife to discover and facilities to help you enjoy and explore the Park. These include a BBQ and picnic area, a pond with viewing platform and clearly marked trails with accessible paths and seating. QUARRYMILL BARBECUE AREA – GUIDANCE FOR GROUPS

The Barbecue Area at the Quarrymill Woodland Park is a public amenity provided by the Gannochy Trust and may be used by any member of the public on a first-comefirst-served basis. We cannot guarantee you will have exclusive use of the facilities.

Things to be aware of:

- 1. We ask that groups of 30+ notify the Trust before visiting. This is not a booking system and notification does not provide any priority of use over other users.
- 2. Anyone using the area is expected to tidy up and take away their rubbish.
- 3. The Trust provides safe barbecue areas for your use. Instant barbecues can be used on the grills provided but must not be used on the grass or benches. Free standing barbecues can be used in these areas. For hygiene purposes, do not place food directly on the grills.
- 4. No fires or barbecues can be lit outside of the designated barbecue areas.
- 5. We do not accept responsibility for the operation of the area.
- 6. A key for the outside toilet at the Coffee Shop (for out-of-hours use) may be booked in advance and, between April and mid-October, obtained from the Shop Manager on payment of a deposit, Tel. 01738 633890. From mid-October to the end of March, contact the Gannochy Trust to access the toilet key.
- 7. The Woodland Park is regularly patrolled.
- 8. Damage and vandalism will not be tolerated.

Parking:

Please note that there is a limited amount of parking at the Macmillan Coffee Shop. Minibuses, and where possible cars, should park at the Scone end of the Woodland Park and not at the Coffee Shop.

First Aid:

All users of the park are responsible for their own first aid provision. Users should ensure they have access to a mobile phone in case of an emergency
